# Audition Details

### Evaluation:

Dancers will take "class" where they will be evaluated, based on work ethic and technical variables, and will be taught a short combination to demonstrate movement quality and performance capability.

Clothing - In order for instructors to best evaluate, it is important to dress in proper dance clothes (ie form-fitting tops, leggings, shorts, leos).

Shoes - Jazz or Ballet shoes are preferred, but bare feet are acceptable. No socks please, due to safety issues.

Hair - Plan to have dancer's hair up neatly and out of the face. Minimal to no jewelry please (only stud earrings).

### Results:

Dancers will be notified, via email, of their audition results/placement within 24-48 hours of the audition. On Sunday, June 2nd, the dancer and at least one parent must attend a mandatory company meeting with their director to go over the company handbook, sign up for summer requirements, be measured, etc.

During this time, Kim choreographed solos and team routines, competed locally and nationally, and was repeatedly recognized as an All-American Dancer. Kim continued in dance on a scholarship to Blinn College Treasures Dance Team, traveling and competing nationally. Her education continued at Texas State University, in San Marcos, where she obtained a Bachelors of Science in Dance.

During her studies of dance, she landed a teaching position at Hermann and Sons School of Dance, in New Braunfels, where she later became the studio's director. Further training was obtained while assisting dance directors at Baily Middles School, in Austin, and San Marcos High school, teaching conventions and master classes prepping dancers for auditions.

In 2006, Kim served as the youth director and mini company director for another local studio company, where she later became the coordinator and office manager for Blast Dance Convention. Three years later, in 2009, Kim opened her own business, where she was able to share the love of dance with pre-school children all over the Austin and surrounding areas. Her passion continued while working at yet another local studio, where she became the office manager and director of their youth program.

In 2018, Kim moved to another local studio, where she was an office administrator and instructor for all ages; she later added the title of Mini/Petite Company Director. No matter where Kim calls her dance home, she continues to share her love of dance with as many children as she can and will keep doing so in her years to come.

# Summer Requirements

**Classes/Intensives:** Enrollment in the following requirements are mandatory. With summer travel taken into consideration, makeup classes can be scheduled to complete the summer class requirements.

- Envision will be required to take **1 ballet and 1 jazz class per week** over the summer. Makeup classes should be taken to meet the requirement for any summer travel.
- Envision dancers are required to attend **The Dance Spot Intensive 7/9-12**. If they are not able to attend, they must attend another summer intensive (Ballet Intensive or Discovery Intensive).
- Weekly workshops (optional) are offered to allow dancers to immerse themselves in certain genre-specific specialties.

**Choreography Week 7/22-27:** This schedule will be aimed to fall between 9am and 4pm, dependent upon schedule restrictions. We will set all team competition choreography during this week. Specific dates and times per team will be released shortly after auditions, once all teams have been finalized. If you cannot attend Choreography Week, you may be required to learn dances in private lessons with the director at extra cost, or may not be able to participate in the 2024-25 Envision season.

**Company Retreat TBD:** \$50 – This cost includes lunch and snacks, activities, and a retreat memento, and will be an exciting team bonding experience! This event will be scheduled during the summer once dancer summer schedules have been collected.

## INTENSIVE DESCRIPTIONS:

**THE DANCE SPOT INTENSIVE (required): July 9th through 12th** – Our Dance Spot Intensive is designed to inspire dancers and further their training in a welcoming, all-inclusive environment. Classes will be taught by our passionate, engaging, in-house instructors. Ages 8-11 (Beg/Int) \$300, ages 12+ (Int/Adv) \$300

**Ballet Intensive (highly recommended): June 10th-14th** – The Ballet Intensive curriculum focuses on strong technique rooted in classical ballet with elements of contemporary movement. It is designed to help advanced dancers in the development of solid technique and artistic style through the challenging combinations and variations presented in each class. L1/2 (3 days) \$170, L3 \$375, L4 & L5 \$425

**Discovery Summer Intensive (highly recommended): July 30-Aug 1** – Our Discovery Intensive is dedicated to the growth of each dancer as a physical technician, as well as an expressive and articulate artist.
