



DANCE JAM

May 21st

Ages 5-7 | 5-6pm

Our younger dancers will join in with the Rise Dance Collective "Dance Jam."

These dancers will take the audition just like a dance class.

May 24th

Ages 8-11 | 5:30pm-7:00pm

Ages 12+ | 7:00pm-8:30pm

Evaluation:

Dancers will take "class" where they are to be evaluated based on work ethic, and technical variables, and will be taught a short combination to demonstrate movement quality and performance capability.

Clothing - In order for instructors to best evaluate, it is important to dress in proper dance clothes (ie leggings, shorts, crop tops, leos) Please do not wear baggy clothing. Shoes - Jazz or ballet shoes are preferred but bare feet are acceptable. No socks please due to a safety issues. Hair - Plan to have hair up neatly and out of your face. Minimal to no jewelry is encouraged.

Results:

Dancers will be notified, via email, of their audition results/placement by May 25th at 12pm. Between Wednesday, May 26th and Thursday, May 27th, at least one parent and dancer must attend a 2x1 meeting with their division director to sign up for all summer and fall requirements, be measured, etc. Summer classes start Monday, June 7th, and end Thursday, July 29th. The fall session begins Monday, August 16th.
