She has adjudicated dance/talent competitions and travels where she is needed to teach dance workshops, as well as to choreograph competition solos and group routines. AnnMarie specializes in Hip Hop, Contemporary, Ballet, and Musical Theatre. She performed in productions of "West Side Story" (Margarita), "The Pajama Game" (Poopsie), and "A Chorus Line" (Cassie), and also choreographed for Community Theater and High School productions of "Guys and Dolls", "Wizard of Oz", and "The Nutcracker". She has both studied with, and had her work performed, for Emmy-winning choreographers, Mia Michaels, Wade Robson, Tyce Diorio, Brian Friedman, Cris Judd, Chuck Maldonado and Kevin Maher, among others. After having pre-registered, Students need to prepare a short monologue (no longer than one minute) and a 32 bar cut of a Musical Theater song (roughly one minute).

All students will then learn a short dance combo (4-6 eight counts), so should be dressed ready to dance upon arrival. Jazz shoes are recommended, but not required.

Evaluation:

Spotlight director will evaluate performers based on work ethic, attitude and performance quality (and previous class attendance for returning company members).

Results:

Dancers will be notified by Friday, May 15th, via email, of their audition results/placement. After that, one parent and dancer are REQUIRED to attend a mandatory 2x1 meeting with the director the week after Memorial Day Weekend, to sign up for all summer and fall requirements, be measured, etc. Summer classes start Monday, June 8th, and end Thursday, July 30th. The fall session begins on Monday, August 17th.
